The Numeracy Assessment is a Graduation Requirement.

The Graduation Numeracy Assessment will not be tied to any course but will measure student proficiency in numeracy and will appear as a stand-alone item on their transcript. A student's overall result will be reported on a four-category proficiency scale. Each category on the proficiency scale will have a corresponding description indicating what skills the student has demonstrated to attain that level. Students can improve their proficiency by rewriting the assessment twice during their graduation years (grades 10 -12).
