Grade Point Average (GPA)

Generally, marks are calculated as follows:

A	86-100%
B	73-85%
C+	67-72%
C	60-66%
C-	50-59%
I	0-49%

Students who receive an 'I' will be given a time-specific plan to demonstrate minimum learning outcomes for completion of the course. If they are not able to achieve these minimum outcomes, the 'I' will be converted to an 'F'.

Your Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated using a 4 point system:

A	4.0
B	3.0
C+	2.5
C	2.0
C-	1
I or F	0

To determine your G.P.A.:

1. Assign each letter grade its numerical value.
2. Total the numerical values.
3. Divide the total by the number of letter grades you have received.

Example:

Subject	Letter Grade	Grade Point
Math	B	3.0
P.E.	C+	2.5
French	B	3.0
Science	C	2.5
	Total	10.5
GPA = 10.5 (total) / 4 (# of courses) = <u>2.625</u>
