



Core Competency Presentations of Learning Grade 7

WHAT & WHY?

Whether you notice or not, you use your Core Competencies every day inside and outside of school. The goal of this project is for you to create a Presentation of Learning built on reflection and evidence of these competencies. This project is an opportunity for you to show when you've demonstrated great strength and when you've seen growth over the course of this school year.



HOW?

You will be provided with class time throughout the school year to learn about each of the Core Competencies. Through reflection you will identify times when you have demonstrated the Core Competencies and collect evidence of your learning this year and build your Presentations of Learning.

WHEN?

At the end of June all grade 7's will be required to attend one final day of school where they will present their Presentations of Learning to teachers and peers. Following this presentation, you will also complete a written self-assessment of all three Core Competencies to be sent home with report cards on the last day of school.

TASK:

For the individual Presentations of Learning, grade 7 students will be expected to...

- Explain how you have demonstrated growth of **one** Core Competency over the course of this school year in a presentation. Presentations should include the following:
 - Explain why you have chosen that Core Competency and what it means in your own words.
 - Use at least 3 specific examples of when you have used, developed, and explored this Core Competency (inside or outside of school).
 - Give a presentation on the Core Competency you have chosen during a gallery walk (multiple people presenting at the same time).
- Complete a written self-assessment on **all three** Core Competencies.

FAQ:

- Presentations can be any format you choose. Be creative!
- Presentations must include at least one artifact (physical evidence of learning experience and/or growth).
- Presentations should be 3-5 minutes long.
