



Core Competency Presentations of Learning Grade 8

WHAT & WHY?

Whether you notice or not, you use your Core Competencies every day inside and outside of school. The goal of this project is for you to create a Presentation of Learning built on reflection and evidence of these competencies. This project is an opportunity for you to show when you've demonstrated great strength and when you've seen growth over the course of this school year.



HOW?

You will be provided with class time throughout the school year to learn about each of the Core Competencies. Through reflection you will identify times when you have demonstrated the Core Competencies and collect evidence of your learning this year and build your Presentations of Learning.

WHEN?

At the end of June all grade 8's will be required to attend one final day of school where they will present their Presentations of Learning to teachers and peers. Following this presentation, you will also complete a written self-assessment of all three Core Competencies to be sent home with report cards on the last day of school.

TASK:

For the individual Presentations of Learning, grade 8 students will be expected to...

- Teach a skill or personal strength of your choosing to highlight **two** Core Competencies out of the three.
 - Explain why you have chosen each Core Competency and what it means in your own words.
 - Your skill should demonstrate **both** Core Competencies you have chosen to highlight.
 - You will be teaching your skill or strength to a roundtable of your peers.
 - You will be responsible for bringing any materials or resources you may need to teach your skill on your teaching day.
- Complete a written self-assessment on **all three** Core Competencies.

FAQ:

- You are welcome to explore and teach any skill related to school or other areas of your life. You can do this with support of a video or powerpoint if needed.
- You must be prepared to teach about 15 of your peers and a teacher.
- You will be given an opportunity to request a unique space suited to your skill, if needed. Example: teaching Frisbee skills requires being outdoors.
